

Release & Retreat Terms

Version 2.2 | July 2026

This is a legally binding contract. By submitting your registration and/or making any payment for the retreat, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to all the terms below.

Thank you for joining us. We have designed this retreat with care, intention, and deep respect for your well-being. These terms help create a safe, joyful, and transformative experience for everyone.

1. Assumption of Risk & Voluntary Participation

You are voluntarily participating in the retreat, including all activities, excursions, meals, coaching sessions, and travel to, from, and during the event.

You understand that travel and group activities involve inherent risks, including but not limited to physical or psychological injury, illness, disfigurement, temporary or permanent disability (including paralysis), emotional distress, or loss. These risks may arise from your own actions or inaction, the actions or negligence of others, travel conditions, or the nature of the activities themselves (such as walking tours, cooking classes, day trips, sightseeing, or other experiences).

You knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, and agree to participate at your own risk.

2. Release of Liability

In consideration for being permitted to participate and for the services provided, you (on behalf of yourself and your heirs, next of kin, and representatives) release Stacey Robbins, Robert “Rock” Robbins, Stacey Robbins Productions / Stacey Robbins Consulting, and their employees, agents, volunteers, and contractors (collectively “SRC”) from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, or causes of action for any injury, loss, damage, illness, or expense (including medical costs or attorney’s fees) arising from your participation in the retreat, including travel to, from, and during the event — even if caused by the ordinary negligence of SRC.

This release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by California law.

3. Physical Activities & Health Acknowledgement

The retreat may include physical activities such as walking, light movement, yoga, cooking classes, and sightseeing. You affirm that you are in good physical and mental health and do not have any medical condition that would prevent or limit your safe participation. You agree that it is your responsibility to consult with a physician if you have any concerns about your ability to participate.

You assume full responsibility for exceeding your own physical or mental limits and release SRC from any related claims.

4. Payment, Cancellation & Refund Policy

- The deposit is **strictly non-refundable** under all circumstances.
- All remaining payments become fully non-refundable **80 days before the start of the retreat**.
- No refunds will be issued for any reason, including medical or family emergencies, acts of God, pandemics, travel restrictions, or other force majeure events.
- In such cases, SRC will make reasonable efforts (at its sole discretion) to offer a credit or rescheduling option, but is not obligated to do so.
- Transfers of your spot to another qualified participant may be considered at SRC's sole discretion after an interview. No refund is issued if a transfer is not approved.

5. Property & Community Guidelines

You agree to respect all retreat property rules, including the **strict no-smoking policy** (no smoking, vaping, or e-cigarettes on any retreat property or in any retreat vehicle) and quiet hours (9:00 PM – 8:00 AM). Violations may result in removal from the retreat without refund.

6. Travel Insurance Requirement

Comprehensive **travel insurance** (covering trip cancellation/interruption, medical emergencies, evacuation, and missed connections) is **required** for all participants. SRC is not responsible for any losses, expenses, or issues that would have been covered by adequate travel insurance.

Flights, insurance premiums, personal spending money, missed transports, and free-day expenses are **not included** in the retreat fee and remain your sole responsibility.

7. Media & Photo Release

You grant SRC permission to take photographs, videos, and recordings of you during the retreat and to use them for promotional, marketing, and archival purposes (including websites and social media). **You may opt out of this media release by notifying SRC in writing prior to the start of the retreat.**

8. Governing Law & Miscellaneous

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior understandings or agreements. You represent that you are 18 years of age or older. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California. Any disputes shall be resolved exclusively through binding arbitration in Orange County, California.

If any portion of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder will continue in full force and effect. You acknowledge that you have read this document carefully, understand its terms, and are entering into it freely and voluntarily. You are strongly encouraged to have this Agreement reviewed by your own attorney before registering.
